Program Cost:

The expenses for YCC-YEP include 1 weeks lodging, 1 weeks meals, transportation, training materials, access to the Business Innovation Group Fabrication Laboratory, and an entrepreneurial mentorship team. The entire program is calculated at \$1,695 per person. The YCC-YEP 2019 summer program is June 3-7, 2019. Registration is from February 26, 2019 through May 24, 2019.
