Youth & Young Adult Virtual Career Counseling (YCC - V20)

July 16, 2020

Due to the outbreak of the Coronavirus pandemic, We have modified our Career Camp program structure and training methodology from the 2 week, Residential Emersion Training Experience (RITE) model, to a Virtual Training and Distance Learning model. We have postponed in person career programs until further notice.

Youth Career Camp - Virtual 2020 (YCC-V20) is a virtual workforce readiness, career exploration, and entrepreneurship camp which provides employability skills, career pathway exposure, postsecondary education preparation, small business and entrepreneurial training.

YCC-V20 is free and will be conducted from **July 27th to August 7th**. There are two program levels. Level 1: Ages 13 - 17, and Level 2: Ages 17 - 21. Learning Objectives:

The objective of YCC-V20 is for participants to learn how to navigate the changing world of virtual work requirements, career options, and how to communicate effectively in such environments. In doing so, the objective is to teach participants:

- To understand how existing organizational skills must change in remote work environment
- To appreciate the challenges of communicating across cultures
- To develop virtual work capabilities based on leading research and practice on remote interaction and computer mediated communication
- To enhance the ability to make effective decisions in virtual work structures

Topics Include:

- How virtual structures are blurring traditional organizational boundaries, requiring new strategies for sustainability
- How to engage Web 2.0 ideas and developing competencies at leveraging the knowledge businesses and organizations will require
- How different models for virtual work (virtual teams, virtual peer-to-peer interactions, virtual communities, virtual worlds) have arisen and the kinds of work that can be accomplished in each
