Guidelines for Volunteers During COVID-19

All volunteers and staff must WEAR MASKS, and follow critical health and safety protocols so we can protect participants, other volunteers, visitors, and our community.

General guidelines for volunteers:

All individuals should consider their level of risk for the virus prior to engaging in any volunteer service. YCCI does not require interaction with high-risk people based on CDC guidelines. Please review the CDC definition for people who are at higher risk for illness.

Please **DO NOT** attempt to volunteer if in the last 14 days you:

- Have any of the symptoms related to COVID-19 as identified by the Centers for Disease Control and the
 Department of Health. Please review symptoms at the Georgia Department of Health website: https://dph.georgia.gov/health-topics/coronavirus-covid-19
- Have been around anyone who has COVID-19
- Traveled to any foreign country
- Been on a cruise or been in an airport
- Been to an event with more than 50 people

DO call ahead to confirm any additional safety precautions before, during and after volunteering.

DO NOT volunteer if you live with or are in frequent contact with people in higher-risk categories for the virus.

DO NOT take part if you feel uncomfortable with the level risk.

DO practice universal infection control precautions:

- Clean and wash your hands for a minimum of 20 seconds before, during, and after volunteering.
- Wear a cloth face covering inside our building, and outside on property grounds, and maintain at least six feet distance form others.

Avoid physical contact with others and maintain a distance of at least six feet.

- Cover your cough and sneezes with your elbow or a tissue.
- If soap and water are not available, use a hand sanitizer that contains at least 60% alcohol. Cover all surfaces of your hands and rub them together until they feel dry.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands.
