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Due to the impact of the Coronavirus pandemic, the Youth Career Commission Inc. modified the 2021 youth career development training methodology from the 2 week, Residential Emersion Training Experience model, to a Hybrid Distance Learning (HDL) model.

The Youth Career Commission 2021 (YCC-2021) program will be conducted using virtual technology and limited in-person practical modules, over a 4 month period from April to July. This modification allows YCCI to increase the utilization of virtual technologies, to incorporate better Science Technology Engineering and Math (STEM) training, while maintaining the integrity of our entrepreneurship program which provides small business and entrepreneurial training, employability skills, career pathway exposure, and postsecondary education preparation.

Learning Objectives:

The objective of YCC-2021 is for participants to learn how to navigate the changing world of virtual work requirements, career options, and discover new pathways to success in uncertain economic times. Participants will have opportunities to learn:

- To develop virtual work capabilities based on leading research and practice on remote interaction, and computer mediated communication
- To understand how existing organizational skills must change in remote work environment
- To appreciate the challenges of communicating across cultures
- To enhance the ability to make effective decisions in virtual work structures
