The YCCI Board of Director reserve the right to consider, approve, or decline all applications, and maintains the right and authority to dismiss any participant from any YCCI program regardless of the applicant's eligibility status.

YCCI Summer Camp has two group levels of participation; Level One is for ages 13-17, and Level Two is for ages 18 - 24. In addition to core training & activities of the overall program, Level Two participants receive additional leadership, mentoring, work readiness training, and job search assistance.

Level One Participants must be age 13 by June 1st, or by the start date of the summer program, if Level One participants turn 18 during the program, they may be eligible for transition to Level Two. This is subject to the best judgment of program leaders.

First time attendees to any YCCI program must have an **Intake Interview before participating.** Parents/Legal Guardians of Level One participants are required to attend the Intake Interview with those participants.

To participate in YCCI programs, applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Turn the age 13 by June 1st, and have guardianship authorization
- Participants age 18-24 undergo mandatory criminal background checks

Although YCCI Statesboro is willing to accept participants from other locations based on space availability, we primarily focus on the Southeast region of Georgia. Applicants from low income families (On Reduced School Lunch Program) and rural areas receive priority seating. Program Cost:

The expenses for YCCI Summer Programs typically include 2 weeks lodging, meals, transportation, training materials, access to technology resources, and field trips. Financial sponsorships are available on a limited bases, and **can reduce the cost of attendance by over 90%**. Entire program cost varies each year, and is estimated at \$1,800 per person. There is a \$175 nonrefundable registration fee for YCC-2023. Depending on sponsorships, eligible participants may be able to attend free of charge.
